Prevention

Ninety percent of sports-related eye injuries may be prevented with protective eyewear. This program distributes free baseball helmets, face guards, and basketball goggles to amateur youth sport teams and protective eyewear to vocational schools throughout the State of Ohio.

Screening

Up to 15 percent of preschool children have an eye or vision condition that, if not corrected, could result in reduced vision. Save Our Sight provides training, certification, and equipment for vision screenings for preschool aged children.

Education

The Save Our Sight Fund supports educational programs that stress the importance of eye safety, eye health and eye protection.

Support

Amblyopia occurs when one or both eyes do not develop normal vision during early childhood.

The Ohio Amblyope Registry, provides information, case management, support services and free eye patches to children and their families.

The Save Our Sight Fund is administered by the Ohio Department of Health.
